Who is Eligible?

- Be at least a high school senior or already enrolled in a college and must have maintained a satisfactory grade point on at least 2.5 of a 4-point scale. **Please submit official transcripts.**
- Scholarship recipient can receive an Insight FS scholarship once per year. **Scholarship applications will be automatically disqualified if they copy and paste essay answers from the previous year.**

Scholarship Award

Insight FS will offer 10 - \$1,500 scholarships to full-time area students with an interest in pursuing a career in agriculture or agribusiness. Scholarships will be awarded upon successful completion of the Fall semester. Payment is provided directly to the school in the student's name.
